

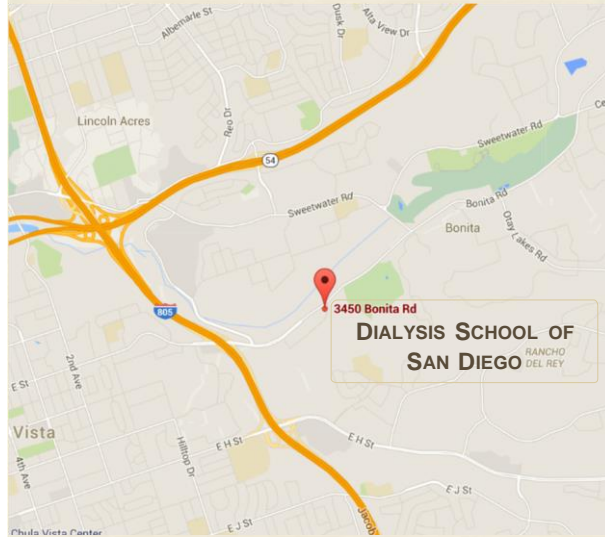

## REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

To be eligible for admission to the program, a prospective student must meet the following requirements:

- Provide proof of High School Diploma or GED
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must pass pre-admission test and interview
- Must be able to read, write, speak, and understand the English language
- Must be able to pass background check and drug test
- Must pass health requirements
- Must have a government-issued picture ID and a valid social security number

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. Physical Clearance from your physician. Form provided upon registration.
2. Lab results: Hepatitis B antibody and antigen. If Hepatitis antibody is negative (below 10), vaccination is encouraged before starting the program.
3. TB skin test within 90 days. If positive, clear chest x-ray is required.
4. Copy of immunization records.
